\*For specialized baccalaureate degrees, at least 20 credits and a minimum of the four specifically required knowledge and skills areas must be completed during the first 60 credits of study.

Other SUNY/SED Program Requirements:

- An associate degree must have a minimum of 60 credits and a maximum of 64 credits.
- A bachelor's degree must have a minimum of 120 credits and a maximum of 126 credits. Bachelor's degree programs should have at least 45 credits of upper division study, with 24 in the major.
- In all degrees except for specialized baccalaureate degrees (see above) the GE credits must be completed within the first 60 credits of the degree.
