

PROJECT SUNLIGHT REPORTING FORM

New legislation effective January 1, 2013 (enacted as part of omnibus ethics legislation Ch. 399, Part A, §4, L. 2011) establishes a database, "Project Sunlight," which makes available to the public data concerning individuals and firms who appear before State entities with respect to five categories of matters: (1) procurement of State contracts, (2) ratemaking, (3) regulatory matters, (4) judicial or quasi-judicial proceedings, or (5) rule-making per the State Administrative Procedures Act. Given the nature of SUNY activities, we are most likely to be impacted in the area of procurement. We are required to report appearances by individuals and firms who appear before SUNY decision-makers or persons who advise decision-makers. System Administration will be handling the entry of these appearance reports centrally. Each time you have an appearance that must be reported, fill out the following form and return via e-mail to within three days of the communication/ appearance.
