### **Position Available – Immediately**

#### Course Overview:

Mosholu Golf Course is a 9-hole golf course renovated by Stephen Kay and Doug Smith in 2006 that dates back more than a century. The course is home to The First Tee of Metropolitan New York, teaching thousands of young people positive values through the game of golf each year and serving as the headquarters for this regional youth development organization. This position represents an opportunity to be a part of a dynamic and growing organization that has a profound impact on the New York Metropolitan community, as well as participating in groundbreaking construction and research projects.

The concession at Mosholu is currently owned on a long-term lease by The First Tee of Metropolitan New York which was founded in 2001 in partnership with the MGA and Met Section PGA. These two Associations are significantly involved with the oversight and operations of the facilities at Mosholu including the maintenance. Mosholu also includes a driving range that is scheduled to be completed in 2013-14 and will have the world's largest green roof at the NYC DEP Water Filtration Plant adjacent to the course. The course is open year-round, and has a new maintenance facility that was built at the same time as the golf course renovations.

#### Job Description:

The Golf Course Superintendent at Mosholu Golf Course will maintain the golf course and grounds at the level as directed by the Executive Director of The First Tee of Metropolitan New York. The goal will be to provide a golf course, as well as the grounds of the facility, in a manner that maximizes the enjoyment of golfers, First Tee participants and their families at Mosholu.

#### Responsibilities:

- Creation of a Master Plan to outline both day to day and long term maintenance goals
- In collaboration with the Executive Director, plan and enact any capital improvement needs
- Responsible for all superintendent duties, including budgeting, equipment and supply purchasing, hiring, training and supervision of staff
- Responsible for overall condition of greens and grounds including range, practice, clubhouse and parking areas, including snow removal
- Pesticide reporting (must hold a valid NYS applicators license) and ensure that maintenance practices are in compliance with federal, state and local laws
- Will act as primary shop and equipment manager, ensuring that all equipment receives scheduled maintenance. Experience in equipment repair, reel grinding and daily preparation of turf equipment is essential. Responsible for overall condition and maintenance of shop facilities
- Represent The First Tee's interests in the planning and design of planned driving range – that will be part of a 10 acre green roof which will be the largest in the world – in collaboration with DEP, NYC Parks and other respective architects and consultants

Requirements:

A minimum of 3 years of experience as a Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent is expected. Desired candidates should exhibit a history of a progression of advancement and a record of flawless professional and ethical conduct. Candidates holding a turf grass or agronomic degree as well as GCSAA Certification are preferred. Candidates should be experienced leaders and possess good written and verbal communication skills. Proficiency in financial management is essential to the position. A valid driver's license and State of New York Pesticides License are required. We are seeking out a diverse applicant pool for this position that reflects the core philosophy of The First Tee to **provide opportunity for advancement for people of all backgrounds**

Compensation:

A comprehensive compensation package based upon experience will be offered to the final candidate. The package will include: A competitive salary, health, life, disability and dental insurance, payment of membership dues in the GSCAA and MetGCSA, and a continuing education budget. Starting salary range of \$55,000-\$65,000.
