Presby Memorial Iris Gardens, Upper Montclair, NJ

Summer 2011. The Essex County Presby Memorial Iris Gardens is a living museum housing the largest public collection of irises in the world. The Gardens contain 10,000 irises representing 3,000 named cultivars. The collection boasts registered irises dating back to 1500. During our Bloom Season in May and June, 10,000 visitors from around the world come to see our magnificent “Rainbow on the Hill.” The garden was begun in 1927 and has been listed on the State and National Registers of Historic Sites since 1980. Each year 4-5 iris beds in the Gardens are selected to be renovated. Interns will learn the process of bed renovations, cultivar division and organic bed building, as well as the critical nature of maintaining an iris’ identity during the process. Interns will also learn to recognize and remediate issues pertaining to the health and vigor of this monocrop. Additionally, during our Bloom Season (Mid-May through early June), we sell potted iris plants, perennials and heirloom tomato plants as a fund raiser for the Gardens. Interns work in the plant sale area, answer questions about plant growing conditions and plant care, write up sales slips and keep the plants watered and the displays tidy. As Presby is a non-profit organization, this is an unpaid internship. Interns typically work 35 hours/week at the Gardens during the months of May, June, July and/or August. Some work may be on the weekend. Interns who complete ten or more weeks of satisfactory Garden service will receive a \$500 stipend at the end of the summer. Interns might also be eligible to receive school credit for their work at the Gardens, depending on their individual school’s internship program guidelines.
