COURSE INFO: Knollwood Country Club was founded in 1894 and is one of the oldest private clubs in the country. The golf course was originally designed by Lawrence Van Etten in 1895, and was redesigned by Seth Raynor, Charles Banks, and A.W. Tillinghast in 1926. Stephen Kay added subsequent enhancements, and architect, Ian Andrew put a restorative master plan in place in 2010. Over the past three years the club has embarked on the restoration of two holes, and an ongoing green expansion program. While a full service club, Knollwood believes that its golf course is its crown jewel and is seeking a superintendent with the knowledge and experience to continually enhance the clubs golfing experience. The course is 6400 yards and a par 71. Maintenance staff is unionized.

RESPONSIBILITIES: The Superintendent reports directly to the Greens Chairman, and will coordinate operations with the Club Manager and Director of Golf. The Superintendent is responsible for all aspects of maintenance for the golf course, grounds and clubhouse as well as development of the maintenance department's annual operating and capital budgets and efficient use of those funds. He must be dedicated to providing respectful mentoring and motivation of the staff for maximum productivity. He should be visible and attentive to the membership with a willingness to address their concerns for the golf course and overall grounds maintenance. Must be open to a flexible work schedule.

QUALIFICATIONS: Experience as a Superintendent or 1st Assistant Superintendent at an 18-hole, private Club with proven results in maintaining quality conditions. Completion of a four-year bachelor's degree in turf and turfgrass management from an accredited university is preferred. GCSAA certification preferred but not required. Must be a member and active participant in on-going education of GCSAA and local chapter. Must possess a New York State pesticide applicators license, or be able to obtain one within 120 days of employment. Experience maintaining high quality bent/poa putting surfaces a must. A proven track record of maintaining championship caliber playing conditions in the northeast, preferably in the tri-state area is a plus. Prospective candidates must have a proven track record of working with private club membership, greens committee, Club Manager, and Head Golf Professional to implement plans for consistent improvement of the golf course. Must exhibit strong verbal and written communication skills. Must be computer literate with ability to access various resources for up-to-date agronomic information. Must have successful experience interfacing with golf course architects and golf course construction companies. Must be environmentally sensitive and willing to comply with environmental regulations. Candidates should have experience undertaking projects above and beyond daily maintenance, including irrigation work, drainage work, new tee and green expansion, and bunker renovation.
