The Skaneateles National Community Decentralized Wastewater Demonstration Project was initiated to introduce alternative onsite wastewater treatment technologies in the Skaneateles Lake Watershed. The Skaneateles watershed offers many challenging site conditions. Advanced technologies help protect this high quality water resource that is used as an unfiltered drinking water supply for the City of Syracuse. By demonstrating design, installation, operation and maintenance, the project has expedited the introduction of alternative systems to the region.

The New York Onsite Wastewater Treatment Training Network, Inc. (OTN) represents various industry professionals, including specialists from the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC), the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) and the New York State Department of State (NYSDOS), and provides hands-on training to those involved in the onsite industry.

SUNY Delhi provides OTN training throughout New York State through an agreement with the NYSDEC to improve regulatory compliance and water quality.
