Re: Upcoming Fire Inspections

Beginning on Wednesday, September 15, the Office of Fire Prevention Control (OFPC) will be conducting their annual safety inspections across campus. Inspections are not limited to just hallways and common areas, but include bedroom spaces as well. Please be aware that your room may be opened and visually inspected by Fire Prevention and Residence Life staff.

Among the potentially hazardous conditions we will be looking for are:

- extension cords
- overstuffed furniture
- flammable items, such as candles, incense, etc.
- tampered with or covered fire safety devices
- items that prevent exiting from an area

If you notice any of these hazards, please report them to your Residence Hall Director immediately.

Students found in violation of the campus fire safety policies will be held accountable through the campus judicial process. In addition, OFPC can levy fines for violations of the State fire code.
