Delhi Faculty/Staff Giving is Tops

SUNY Delhi faculty and staff reach deep to help students and ensure Delhi delivers an exceptional education to students. Delhi stands out among the Colleges of Technology with the highest percentage of faculty and staff making contributions annually.

Around 50 percent of Delhi faculty and staff, current and retired, give to the Annual Fund compared to the following technical sector colleges: Morrisville and Canton, 35 percent; SUNY IT, 25 percent; Alfred, 20 percent; and Cobleskill, 16 percent.

Lucinda Brydon, Alumni/Annual Giving Coordinator, heads the

annual faculty/staff campaign and says it's one of the finest examples of how faculty and staff are committed to student success. "It doesn't matter if you are a State, CADI or Foundation employee or what your union affiliation is, we all feel part of one SUNY Delhi family and want to do what we can to make a positive difference," says Brydon. "That's why I look forward to working with President Vancko and our terrific committee on this campaign each year."
