

NEW VICE PRESIDENT FOR ADMINISTRATION NAMED AT SUNY DELHI

DELHI, N.Y. ... SUNY Delhi President Candace S. Vancko announced today that Barbara A. Larson of East Lansing, Mich. has been appointed as Vice President for Administration.

“Barbara’s depth of experience will be a tremendous asset for SUNY Delhi,” said President Vancko. “She’s a talented fiscal manager and facilities planner who is committed to meeting the needs of the students.”

Ms. Larson has over fourteen years of experience in higher education administration, and for the last six years, has held the position of vice president of Administrative Services and Finance at Lansing Community College, the ninth largest single community college campus in the nation. In that role, she oversaw facilities planning and operations and all financial services—including accounting and payroll, budget development, risk management, cash operations and purchasing. She was also responsible for Lansing’s department of police and public safety and the campus’s auxiliary services. Ms. Larson’s experience also includes director of budget and purchasing at Washtenaw Community College in Ann Arbor, Mich., and senior budget analyst for Loudoun County, Va.

Ms. Larson’s professional affiliations include the National Association of College and University Business Officers (NACUBO), the Michigan Community College Business Officers Association (MCCBOA) and the Community College Business Officers Association (CCBO), which named her Outstanding Chief Business Officer for Region 10 in 1999. Also, she currently serves as a board member of the Michigan Capitol Girl Scout Council and as its chair of the finance committee.

Ms. Larson holds a M.A. in public policy and administration from the Robert M. LaFollette Center for Public Policy and Administration, University of Wisconsin, where she was the recipient of the American Society for Public Administration’s Outstanding Graduate Student Award. She also holds a B.S., magna cum laude, in economics from Rutgers University, N. J.
