DELHI, NY ... The enrollment services staff at SUNY Delhi want you to know that it's not too soon to be thinking about visiting the campus if you plan on attending classes this fall. The college's Open House on Saturday, April 26, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. is the perfect opportunity to get a start on the enrollment process, and begin your college degree.

SUNY Delhi's Open House, which is targeted to prospective students and their families, give visitors an in-depth look at its four-year bachelor's degrees in Hospitality Management, Golf Course Operations and Information Technology; and its two-year associate's degrees and one-year certificates in Business and Information Technology; Building, Electrical, and Mechanical Technologies; Golf, Plant Sciences, and Recreation; Hospitality Management; Humanities, Social Sciences and Individual Studies; Nursing and Allied Health; Science, Mathematics, Engineering and Technology; and Veterinary Science Technology.

Admissions and financial aid representatives will be available to walk visitors through the admission and financial aid process, and the enrollment services staff will offer campus tours.

In addition to Open House, an Adventure Recreation Fair, hosted by the college's Natural Resource Recreation and Sports program and the Catskill Outdoor Education Corps, will be held from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Campus visitors may test their knowledge and get a student's perspective on adventure recreation through a variety of interactive displays. Highlights will include kayaking, outdoor cooking, hiking and backpacking, as well as fly tying and casting.
