1. Research programs

2. QUESTIONS YOU SHOULD ASK

Large or small college? Which do I prefer? Cost of tuition, room, board, etc.? Urban or rural? North? South? East? West? What is the faculty and student ration?

Is financial aid available? Are there special scholarships for transfer students?

What is the student life like on campus? What athletic teams are available? How do they rank? How many credits will transfer? Will D's transfer?

What GPA do I need? How competitive is this program?

Is there a study abroad program? What are the graduation rates?

Is there a Career Services/ Job Placement Office? How many get jobs after graduation?

3. TALK WITH YOUR ADVISORS AND INSTRUCTORS IN YOUR ACADEMIC AREA

Often your advisor will know what colleges offer your major and some pros/ cons of each.

4. VISIT THE COLLEGE CAMPUSES

5. FILE YOUR APPLICATIONS EARLY - PAY ATTENTION TO DEADLINES

- Send transcripts, payment and supplemental documents as needed:
- College Transcripts
- Standardized test scores (i.e., SAT, ACT)
- High School records
- Interviews
- Supplemental applications
- Letters of recommendation

FOUR FREE APPLICATION FEES: If you graduate with an associate's degree, you get 4 applications waived if transferring to another SUNY. Don't forget to check off the Transfer Waiver box on the payment page at end of application.

6. FINAL TRANSCRIPT

A final transcript from SUNY Delhi MUST be sent when you complete your studies at Delhi College, otherwise it WILL put your application in jeopardy.

7. FILE YOUR FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION EARLY!

The transfer guarantee becomes effective if you are denied admission at all of your four-year college choices." (www.SUNY.edu 10/16/2010) Although the program assures admission to a four-year college, it does not assure admission to a specific campus or major.

- "An opportunity to continue full-time study at a four-year State University college is guaranteed to all New York residents who transfer directly from a SUNY or CUNY two-year college with an AA or AS degree. To be eligible you must:
- 1. File your application with the ASC by March 1 for fall admissions, and by October 1 for spring admission.
- 2. Provide four-year campuses with an official two-year college transcript, showing three semesters of completed studies, by March 15 for fall admission, and by October 15 for spring admission.
- 3. Complete all required supplemental application materials by April 15 for fall admission, and by November 15 for spring admission.

10. FINAL PAPERWORK AND PAYMENT REQUIREMENTS DUE

Once accepted- complete all requirements by dates expected within your enrollment packet.
