

MATH PLACEMENT Cut-Off Scores

Please refer to the printout of the ASSET/COMPASS test results and follow these steps:

1. Look at the results. The last level listed is the level/score that should be written on the Student Information Sheet.
2. Compare ASSET or COMPASS level with the Admissions Placement found on the Student Information Sheet.
3. If both math levels are the same, place the student in that level.
4. If levels differ by one, place student in the higher level (for example, if ASSET says level 1 and Admission Placement says level 2a, then choose 2a).
5. If discrepancy is more than 1 level, placement should be made in consultation with the student.

Remember that the math placement is based on the ASSET/COMPASS results AND the Admissions Placement.
