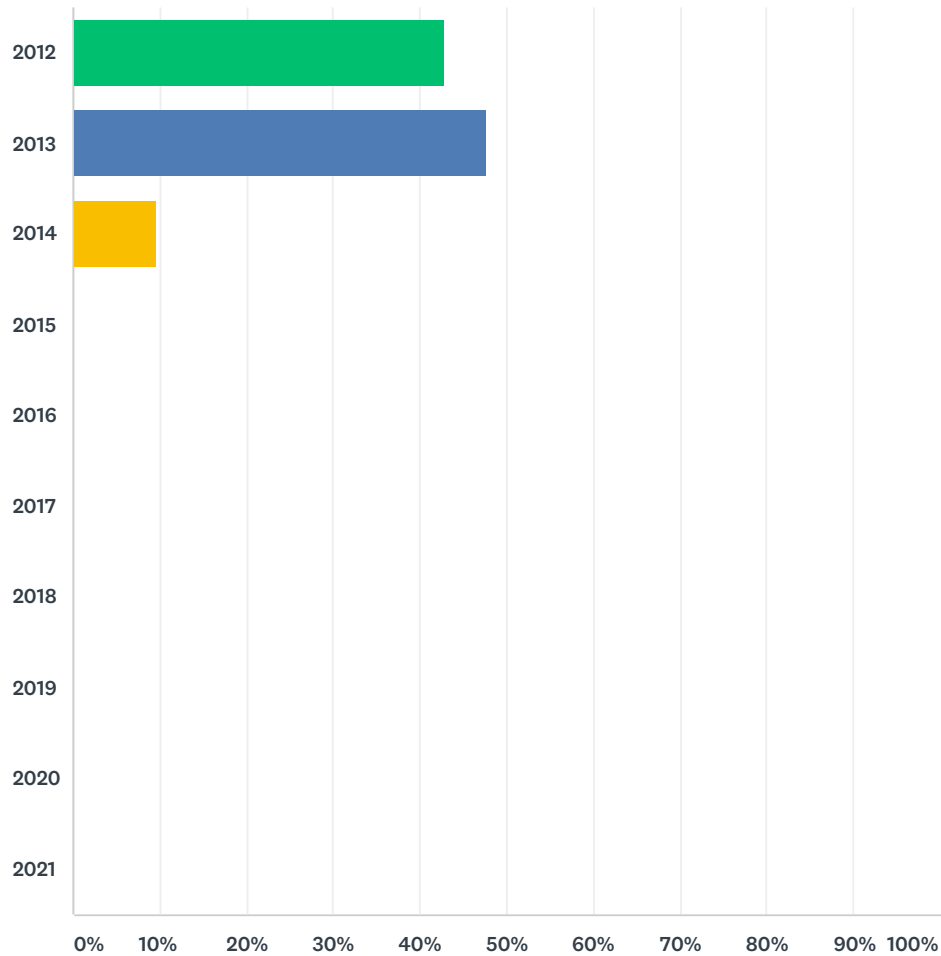

Q1 What year did you graduate ?

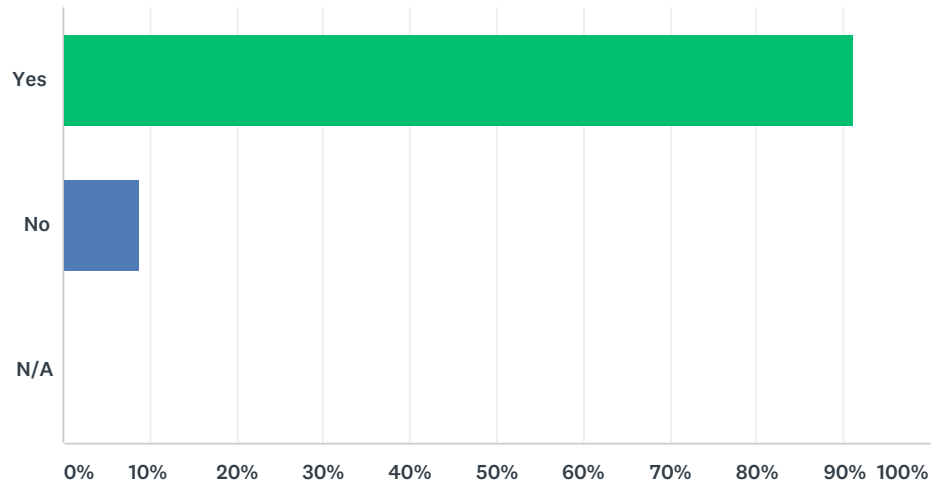

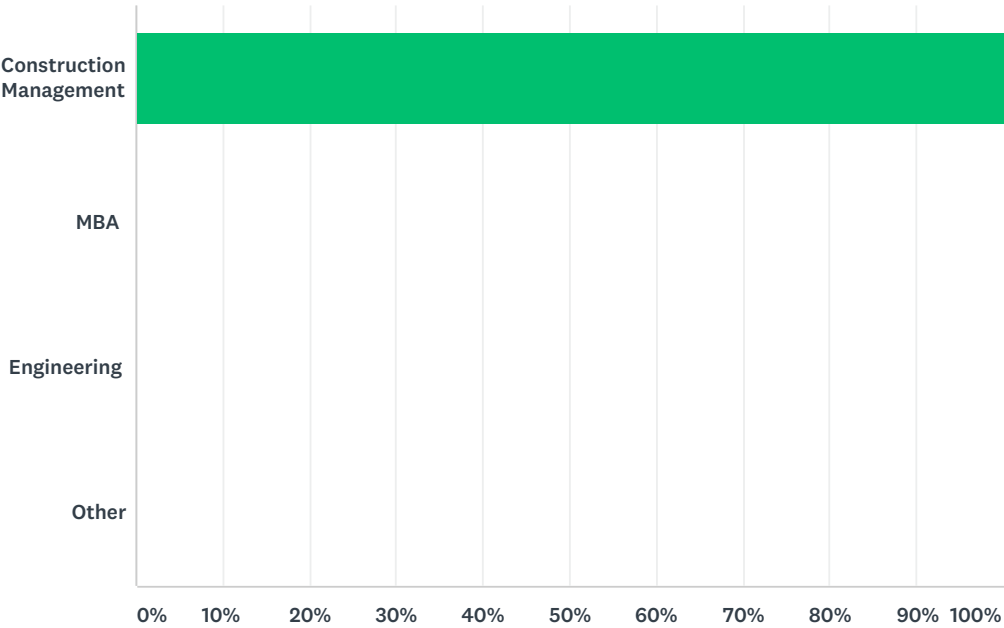

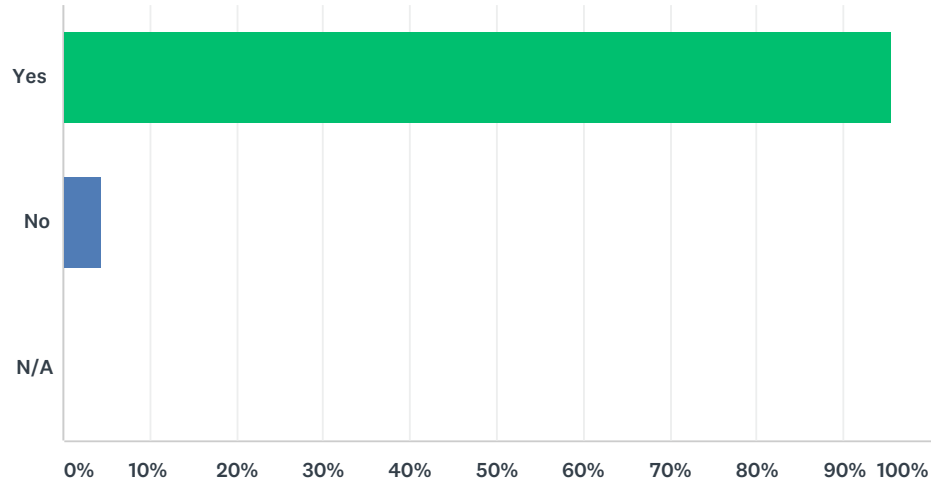

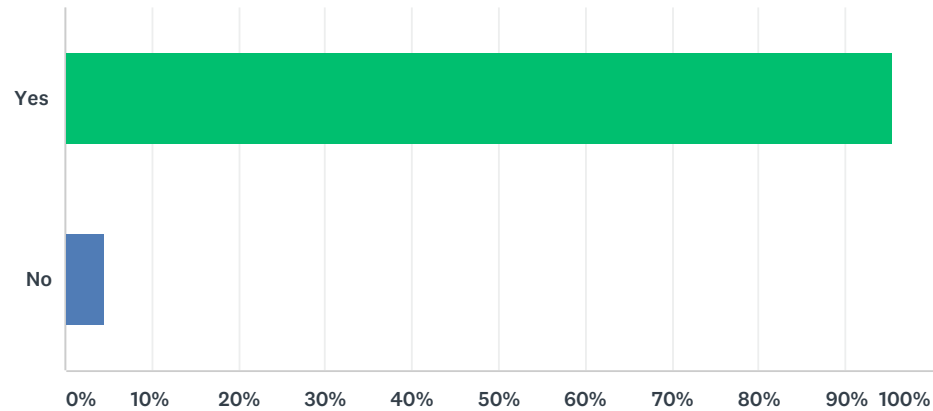

Q6 Are you currently working in the construction industry?

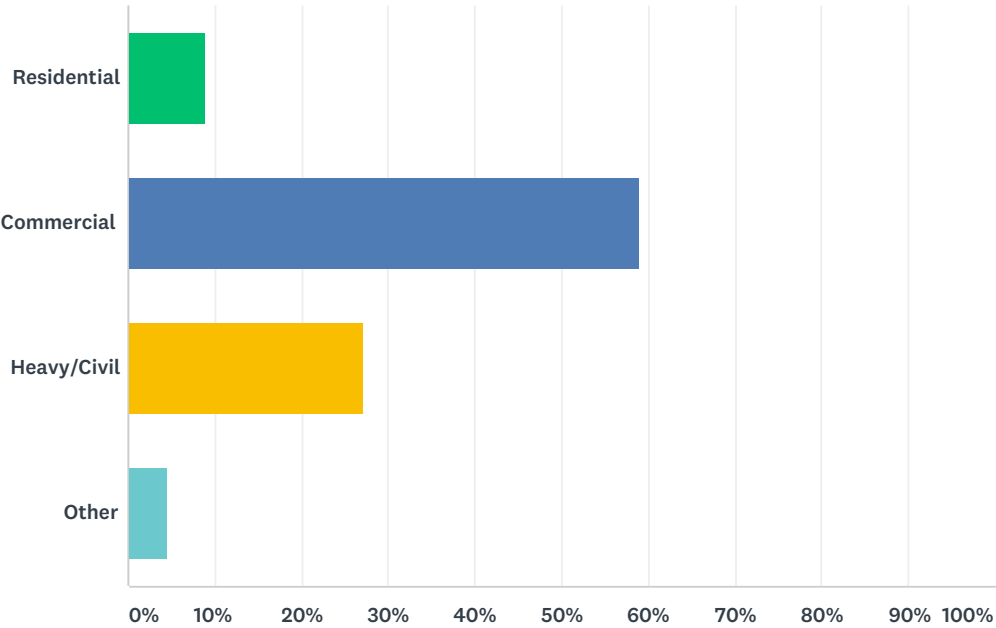

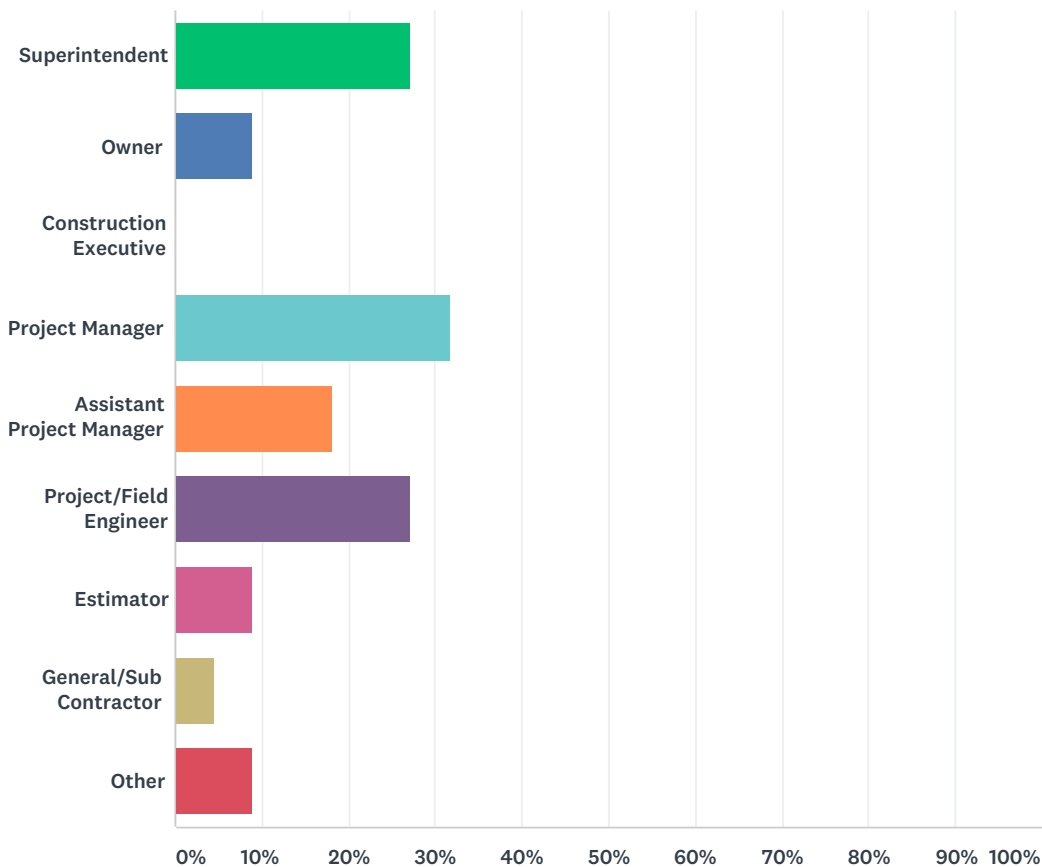

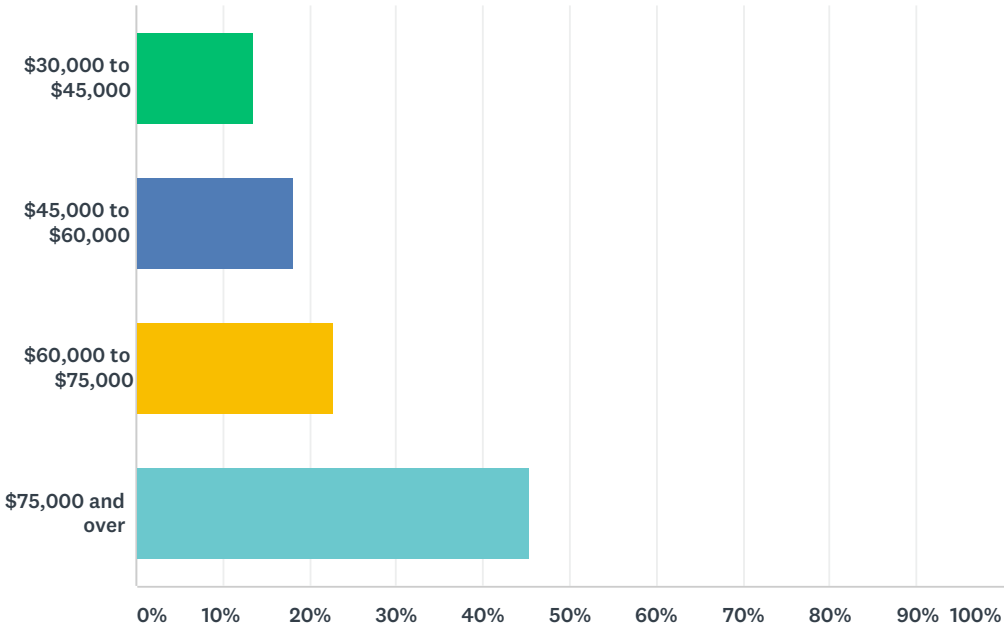

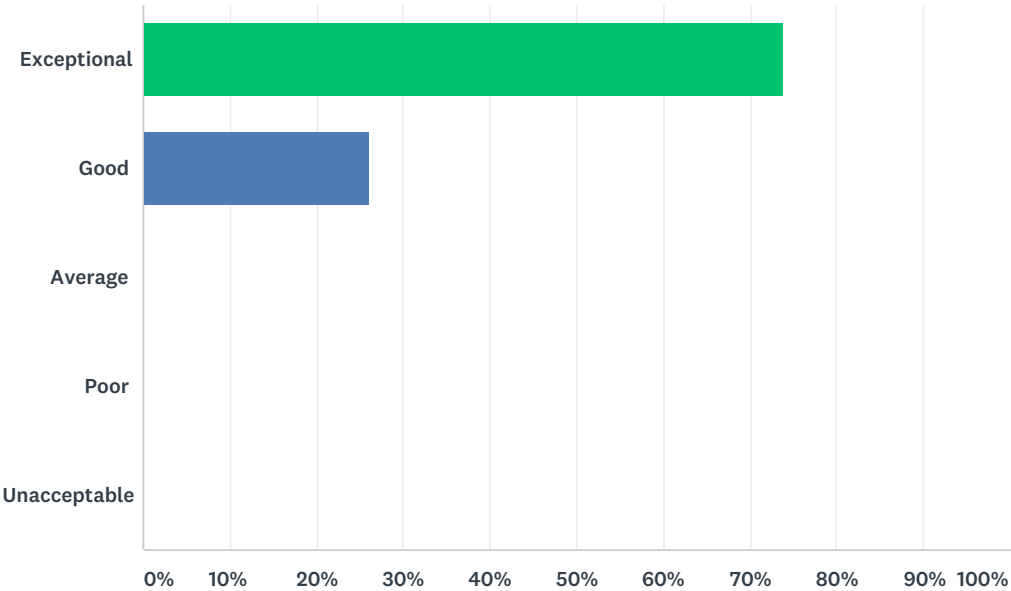

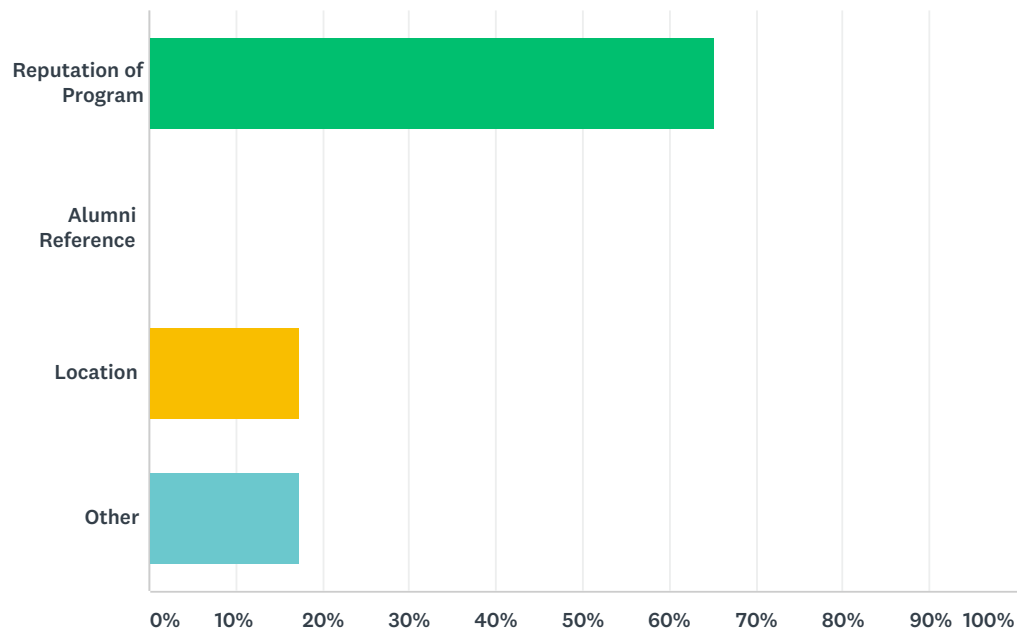

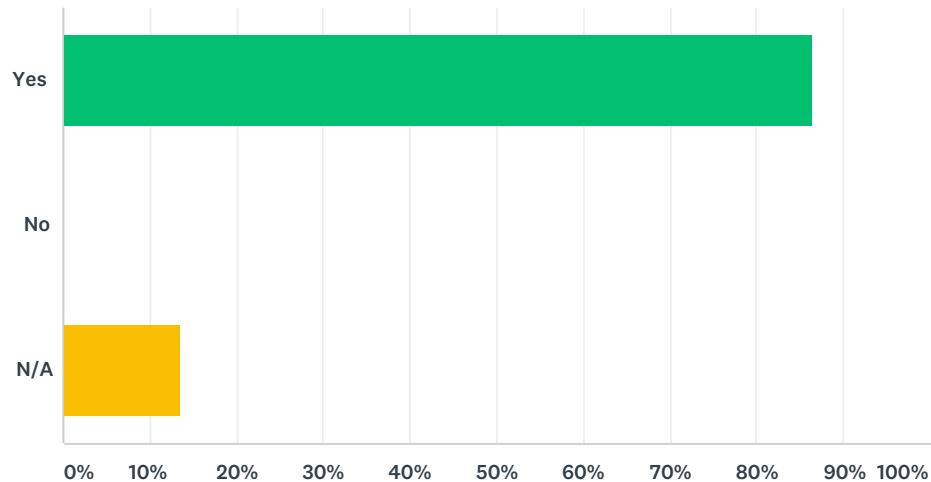

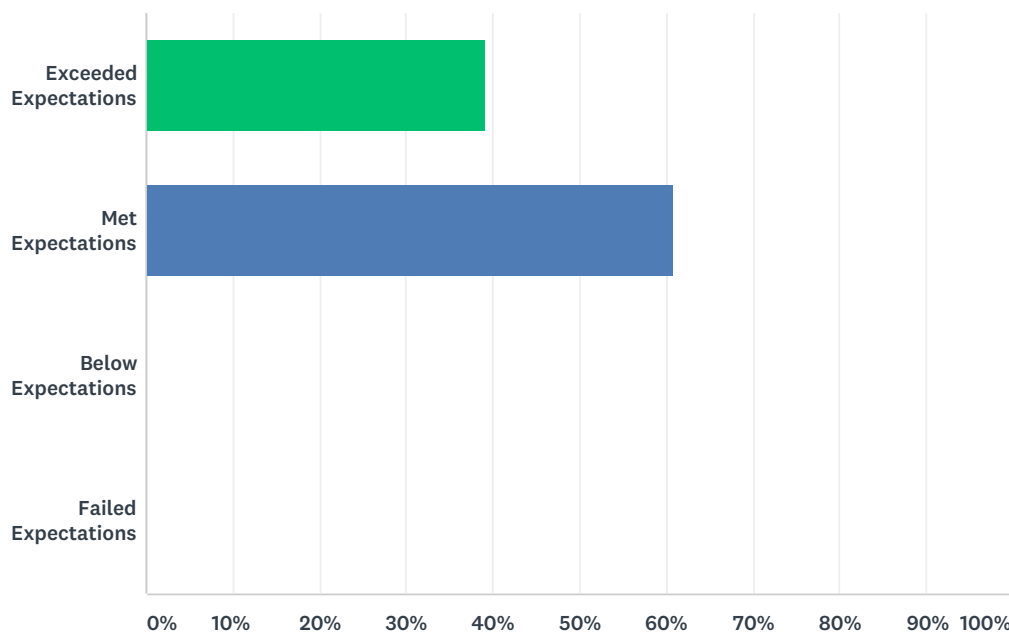

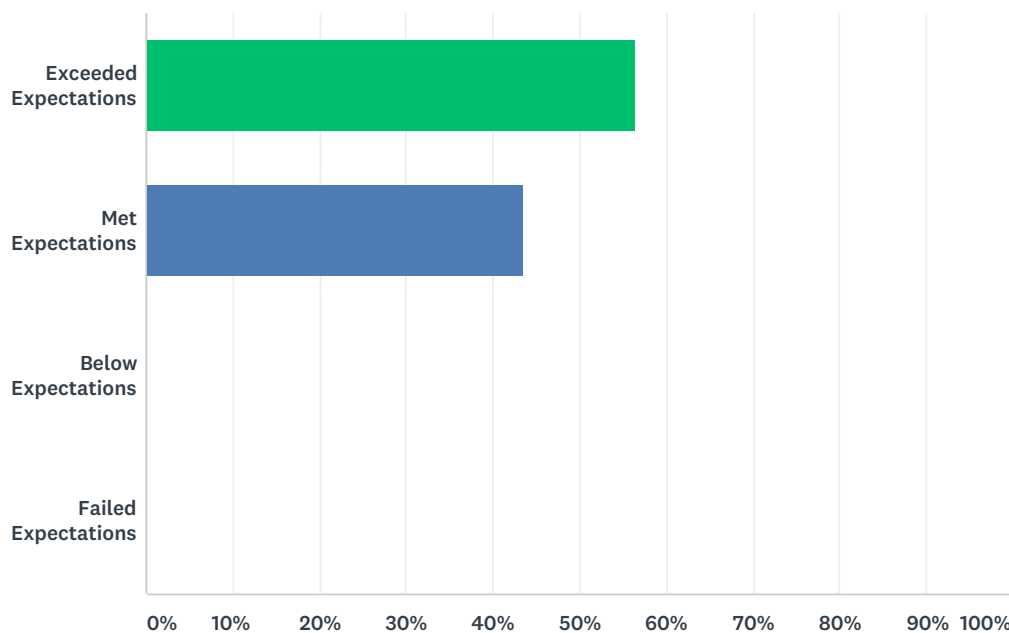

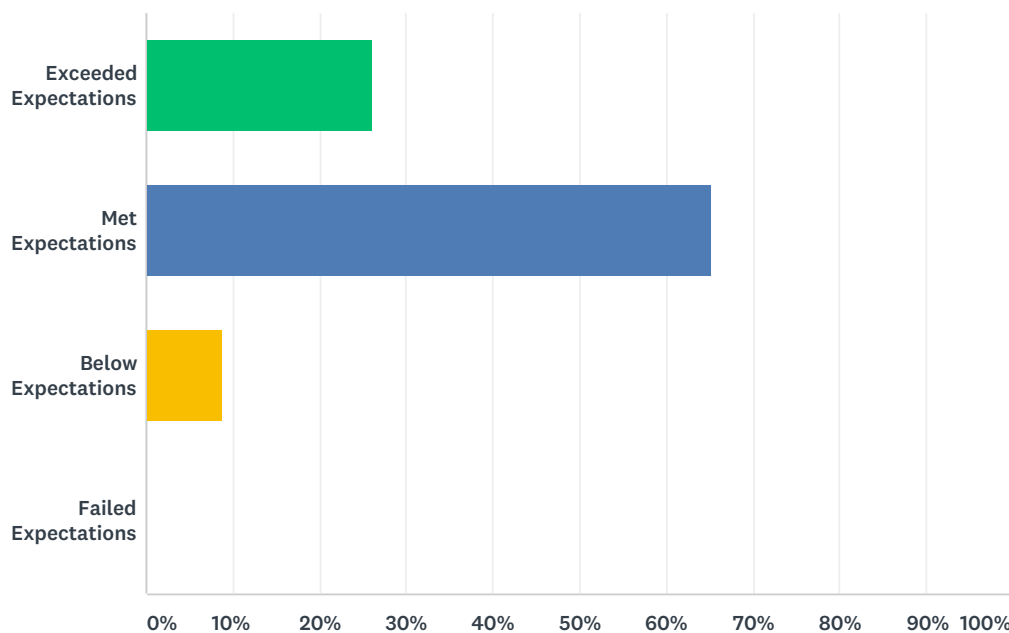

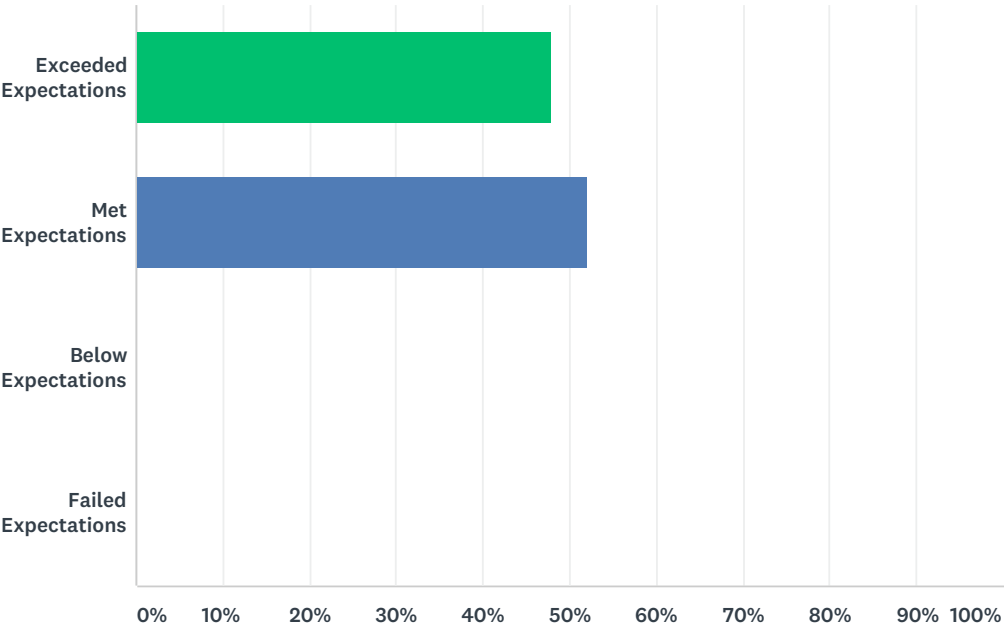

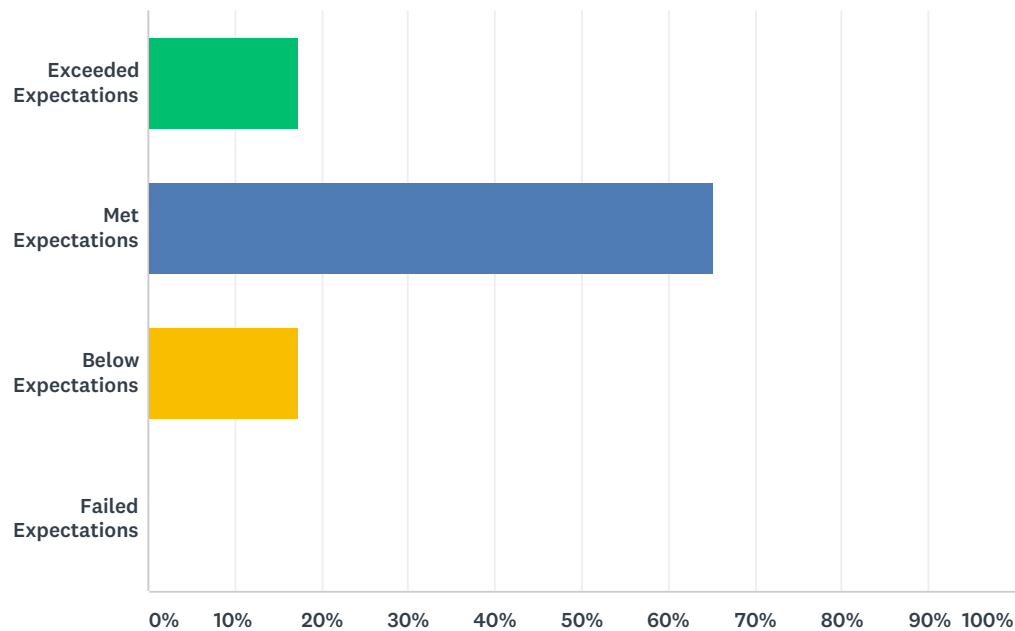

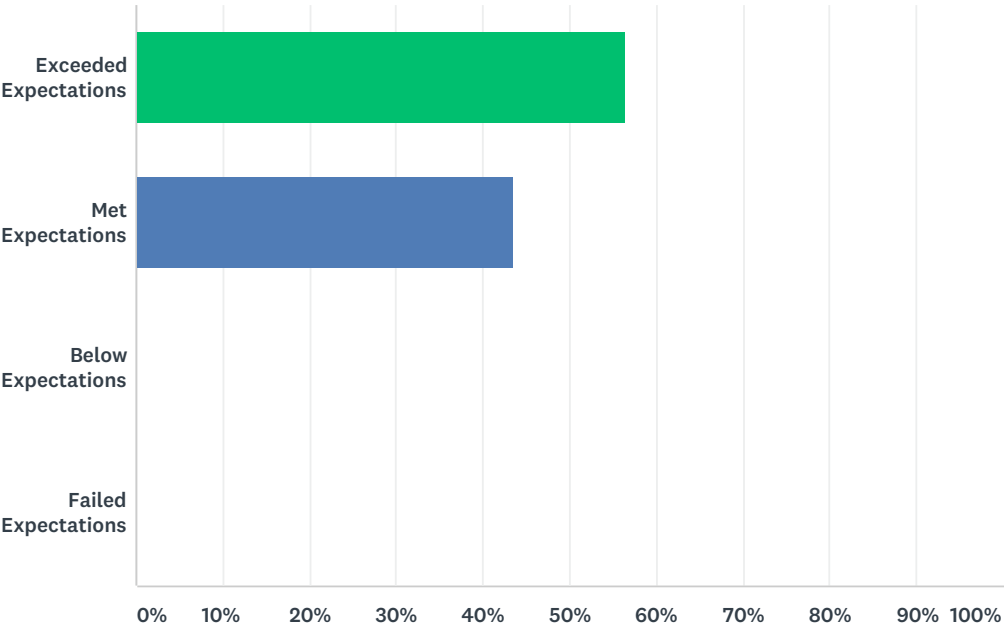
