- Should not exceed 15/16 credit hours until their cumulative GPA is a 2.0 or higher.
- Gives permission to SUNY Delhi to release midterm grade reports and any other pertinent academic information to parents or guardians, within FERPA Guidelines, if they are classified as a dependent.
- May need to enroll in at least one extra semester to complete a specific program of study.
- Must obtain a semester GPA of 2.0 or higher, if they have been academically dismissed and then readmitted.
