B.L.A.S.T.

Bronco Leadership And Success Training (BLAST) is SUNY Delhi's leadership developmental curriculum, linking the events on campus to one of three competencies: Self, Community, or World.

Students who participate in the various events will be awarded a Certificate of Leadership through the Office of Student Activities.

Events sponsored by SUNY Delhi Student Senate Clubs or Organizations may be eligible for BLAST Credit! Talk to the Office of Student Activities in the planning process of your event.

Student Leaders hosting events for BLAST credit are eligible to receive program credits as well!

The Levels of Leadership are achieved by attending a minimum number of programs per category, along with a total number of programs.

Green Level 1

- 3 Self Awareness Events
- 3 Community Events
- 3 World Events
- 12 Events Total

Gold Level 1

- 10Self Awareness Events
- 10 Community Events
- 10 World Events
- 40 Events Total

Green Level 2

- 5 Self Awareness Events
- 5 Community Events
- 5 World Events
- 20 Events Total

Gold Level 2

- 15Self Awareness Events
- 15 Community Events
- 15 World Events
- 50 Events Total

Once the minimum number of events per competency in the Level for which you are working toward has been reached, you may attend events in any competency to reach the total number needed to achieve that Level.

How do I earn BLAST Credits?

For any event with the BLAST Logo on the flyer, there will be an attendance sheet or card swipe. Be sure to sign in to the event. The credits will be applied shortly after for the correct category in which you earned the credits for.



Can I host an event that offers BLAST Credits?

Absolutely! Events sponsored by Student Senate clubs and organizations can count towards BLAST if they are educational based and can apply to one of the three competencies. During the pre-event meeting, a member of the Office of Student Activities will discuss these options.



How can I tell which events offer credits and for which competency?

Any flyer with the BLAST logo offers credits. In the logo there will be one of more letter, either an S, C, or W. These stand for Self, Community, and World. An event may count for more than one competency area, and the logo will show this.



How do I know my credit standing?

For the fall 2017 semester, the credits will be tracked by the Office of Student Activities. Email studentactivities@delhi.edu to check on your credits. A new, online system will be implemented in spring of 2018.



Can I earn credit for hosting an event that offers BLAST Credits?

Yes, hosting an event will earn you one credit for the competency that your event is offering and a bonus credit that applies to the overall number of credits, but not for the competencies.
