



**Information for High School Students Enrolling in  
SUNY Delhi's College in High School Program**

**FALL 2015**

**DEADLINES: (NO EXCEPTIONS)**

**CJUS 100, Intro to Criminal Justice:** Last Day to Register is August 28, 2015

**Online or College Campus:** Last day to register is September 4, 2015

**Traditional College in High School: (Classes taught in High School or Via DL)**

Last Day to register is September 17, 2015

**Cost:** Our program offers a significantly reduced rate to New York State high school students - the current tuition for part-time (up to 11 credits) high school enrollment is \$50 per credit hour (80% savings over the regular \$270/per credit rate). Most courses are worth 3 credits, and some (such as Calculus and Physics) are worth 4 credit hours. SUNY Cost for tuition is \$50 per credit; college fee of \$0.85 per credit and a \$5.00 transcript fee per semester. See fee schedule below.

Important - Students may register for no more than 11 credits per semester at the high school rate.

Please Note - Classes taken on campus may have additional lab fees.

**Payment:** *Payment is due at the time of registration.* If the registration form is received without payment, it will be held until payment is received. Payment may be made by check (payable to "SUNY Delhi") or by credit card. Please check with your school to ask if registration forms and payment are submitted by the school or mail to **College in High School, SUNY Delhi, 226 Bush Hall, 454 Delhi Drive, Delhi, NY 13753.**

**Withdrawing/Dropping Course:** Sometimes students decide that they do not want to take a course for college credit AFTER they've already registered. You must complete a **College in High School Drop Form** to formally drop a course. **Please see drop dates on next page.** Failure to do so will result in a grade of F on your official transcript. *You will receive an email confirmation upon receipt of the completed Drop Form. It is your responsibility to be sure you receive this confirmation.*

**Transferring your College Credit:** Most colleges will accept transfer credits for classes in which a C or better is earned. To transfer your credit after you complete the course, *you must request a transcript from SUNY Delhi to be sent to the college you plan to attend.* This transcript is at no additional cost to you, as the transcript fee is included in your tuition bill. Colleges will generally NOT accept transfer credit from a high school transcript – an official SUNY Delhi transcript must be obtained. Transcripts may be requested by calling Records and Registration at (607) 746-4560.

**Accessing Online Information:** A variety of information is available on our website at [www.delhi.edu](http://www.delhi.edu). An ID number and PIN will be mailed to you after your registration is complete. If you have previously registered, our ID and PIN remain the same. By using your ID and PIN number, you may access Bronco Web, where you can check your account, see your schedule and grades, and request transcripts.

Click on **Student Services and Financial Aid**, then **Student Records**, then **Display Grades**.

**Parking:** If you are taking a course on campus and plan to park a vehicle on campus, you must obtain a parking permit. The cost is \$6.25 per credit hour plus tax. Print a copy of your schedule and take to University Police. Please call 746-4700 in advance to be sure someone is available to assist you.

### **Deadlines:**

#### **Students Taking Classes on Campus or Online:**

Fall 2015 – Classes begin August 31, 2015

June 1, 2015 – First day for high school students to register for an on-campus class

September 4, 2015 – Last day to register for fall course

September 4, 2015 – Last day to drop a fall course without a grade of “W” (w/full refund)

September 25, 2015 – Last day to drop a fall course with a grade of “W” (no refund, no drop fee)

November 6, 2015 – Last day to drop a fall course with a grade of “W” (no refund, \$20 drop fee\*)

\* Drop fees are per class

#### **Traditional College in High school (Classes taught in the high school or via DL)**

Fall 2015

September 17, 2015 – Last day to register for a fall course (**exception: CJUS 100, Registration deadline is August 28, 2015**)

September 25, 2015 – Last day to drop a fall course without a grade of “W” (w/full refund)

October 9, 2015 – Last day to drop a fall course with a grade of “W” (no refund, no drop fee)

November 6, 2015 - Last day to drop a fall course with a grade of “W” (no refund, \$20 drop fee\*)
